Fire & Smoke Damage

Smoke damage is usually the by-product of a fire that contains finely dispensed gases and liquids.

After the fire the gases disperse, but the smoke solids and liquids remain on exposed surfaces. These deposits are called "fire residues".

Fire residues may appear as dry particles, smeary flakes or as a thick and sticky deposit. The type of residue depends on the item or material that has burned.

Smoke residues often emit an obnoxious odour that persists long after the fire. Opening doors and windows to let in outside fresh air will help reduce odours.

Occasionally fire residues penetrate lounge and carpet finishes causing permanent changes in the materials. Because fire residues are often acidic, prompt removal from exposed metal is important to minimise corrosion.

NOTE: In an overwhelming majority of cases, prompt and effective restoration by professionals - can return your smoke damaged furniture or rugs to their original condition.

Sometimes smoke impregnation into soft furnishings can result in the items being totally unsuitable for further use.

Hints & Tips

DO - brush vacuum any loose smoke particles from your upholstery, carpets & draperies.

DO - open your windows & doors for ventilation, if weather permits.

DO - remove pets to a clean environment if heavy fire residues are present.

DO NOT - use carpeting or upholstery impacted by heavy smoke or fire residues.

DO NOT - attempt to WIPE fire residues from upholstery & carpets.

DO NOT - turn on any electrical and computer equipment UNTIL cleaned & checked.
